MEMO FROM THE MANAGER , JOHN WARREN

On Monday, May 2nd, AVCC is holding the Fourth Annual Down Syndrome golf tournament. This tournament has grown every year and is held for an extremely worthy charity. AVCC has a personal connection with this tournament through Ed Kerr:

Dear Fellow AVCC Members:

My name is Ed Kerr. I am on the Board of Directors at AVCC. I have a granddaughter with Down Syndrome.

Four years ago I started a golf tournament to raise money for the Adult Down Syndrome Clinic here in Birmingham. There is only one other clinic like it in the United States and it is full to capacity.

In 1969, the average life expectancy for a child with Down Syndrome was 19. Today it is 59. We desperately need this clinic! Will you help?

Parent Advocates Down Syndrome (PADS) pays the doctors and other expenses at the clinic. The name will change to "The John Mark Stallings Adult Down Syndrome Clinic", with Coach Stallings on hand for the ribbon cutting ceremony, when enough funds are raised.

The Down Syndrome Tournament held at AVCC has become a great fund-raiser for this clinic. Please join us. The entry fee is \$150 per person and is tax deductible.

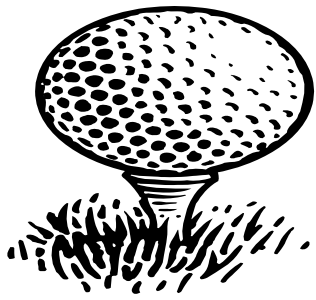

UPCOMING EVENTS:

Masters Saturday Event – Member/Pro Draw - Saturday, April 9th - Tee off anytime - \$20 to draw a pro from The Masters field and you combine your net score with your pro's score from his Saturday round during the Masters. This event is optional to play in and does not close the course to other play.

Senior Monthly – Wednesday, April 13th – 8:30 a.m. shotgun start. Course is open for regular play.

Men's Monthly – Saturday, April 16th – 9 a.m. shotgun start – **“You and Bubba” One Man Scramble** – A Club favorite where you get to play two shots each time and select the best. Flighted with 75% of handicap applied.

Thursday Scrambles Continue - Call by 4:45 of each Thursday to sign-up and we'll shotgun start by 5:15 to get done before dark. This is not a straight scramble on every hole, some are modified with getting to choose the best drive and then playing your ball from there. The cost is \$20 and guests are welcome for an additional \$10, includes a golf cart. Open to both men and women!

JUNIOR CLINICS:

The *Swing Instruction Clinics* continue each Tuesday (ages 8 & up at 4 p.m.) and (ages 5-7 at 5:10 p.m.).

The cost of each “Swing Clinic”: Ages 8 & up - \$10, ages 5 to 7 - \$5. If guests, 8 & up - \$15, 5 to 7 - \$10.

The *On Course Instruction Clinics* for juniors 8 & up continue on Saturdays. During these clinics, juniors are shown how to play on the golf course including; navigating the course, etiquette and pace of play. This will start at 2:30 p.m. sharp, and last for an hour and a half. For any junior that has never played golf I encourage them to attend at least one *Swing Instruction Clinic* prior to coming to the *On-Course Clinic*.

Following the junior clinic, I will have another “*On Course Clinic*” at 4:15 p.m. for ages 5 to 7. This will last only 45 minutes.

The cost of each “On-Course Clinic”: Ages 8 & up - \$15, ages 5 to 7 - \$8. If guests, 8 & up - \$20, 5 to 7 - \$12.

Parents may attend the “On-Course Clinics” and will be provided a golf cart if available.

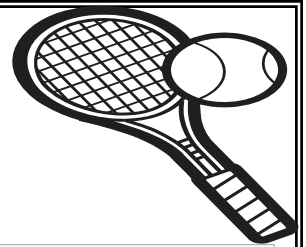

Deadline to sign up for Junior Clinics is the Friday before every week.

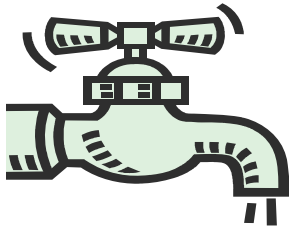

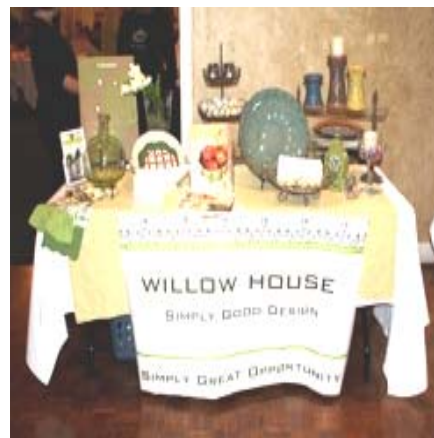


