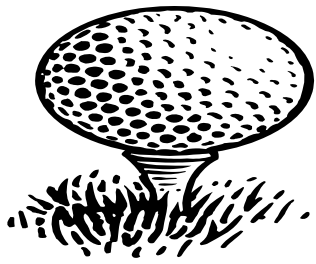

FROM THE PRO: There's a lot going on this month; you'll need to clear your memory bank out for this. The Junior, Senior, and Men's Club Championships are coming up in August. The 13 to 18 year old juniors will now play 36 holes to determine a Champion.

JUNIOR CLINICS:

The junior clinics continue on most Wednesdays (**not one on July 6th because of U.S. Kids Event**). The 8 years and up clinic will be from 9:00 to 10:00 a.m. and the 5-7 year old clinic is from 10:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Guests are welcome to attend.

CLUB GOLF EVENTS:

Club Scramble every Thursday afternoon at 5:30 p.m. Call by 5 to sign up. The cost is \$18 and includes cart; bring a guest for \$10 more. (**Not one on July 7th because of Night Golf on the 8th - see below**)

U.S. Kids Tour Event – Thursday, July 6th – Course is closed all morning until sometime after 11 a.m. To play in this, you must register at www.uskidsgolf.com.

Friday Night Golf – Friday, July 8th – Starts at 5:30 p.m. with our Golf Social format that we usually do on Thursdays (9 hole modified scramble on the front 9), then at dark, we'll illuminate the back 9 and give you L.E.D. lighted golf balls and play a 4-person scramble. Day Golf is \$18 for members and \$28 for guests, Night Golf is \$32 for members and \$42 for guests. Play in one or both, and children may play in the Night Golf but anyone under 18 must be accompanied by a parent. The Seafood Buffet is also going on that evening.

Senior Monthly – Wednesday, July 13th – 8:00 a.m. shotgun start.

Member-Guest Tournament – Friday, July 15th through Sunday, July 17th – Limited to the first 50 Teams. The cost will be \$400 per team with full details of this fun event in The Golf Shop. Friday – Practice round with skins game, chipping contest, and a Calcutta party at 7 p.m., Saturday and Sunday is tournament play with a 9:30 a.m. shotgun start each day. There is also a dinner party Saturday night. **The course will be closed Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The course and range will be closed all day on Saturday and closed Sunday morning until completion of the event, which should be around 2 p.m. (weather permitting).** Sign up in Golf Shop!

UPCOMING AUGUST EVENTS:

Junior Club Championship (1 Day) – Ages 9 to 12 – Thursday, **August 4th** – Tee Times begin at 10 a.m. Age groups: 9-10 will play 9 holes from the red tees & 11-12 will play 18 holes from the red tees.

Junior Club Championship (2 Days & 36 Holes) – Ages 13 to 18 – Friday, **August 4th** & Saturday, **August 5th** – Tee Times begin at 7:30 a.m. on Friday and 11:30 a.m. on Saturday. This is a 36 Hole Stroke Play Event for both age groups. Age groups: 13-14 white tees, 15 to 18 blue tees.

Senior Club Championship – Saturday, August 6th & Sunday, **August 7th** – Sign up in the Golf Shop – Pre-Flighted by age divisions of 50 to 64 (play the white tees) and 65 & up (play the gold tees). Entry Fee is \$50.

Bradley Johnson Memorial 4-Person Scramble – Monday, **August 8th** – 12 o'clock start - \$85 entry fee for members and \$120 for guests (Box Lunch Included). Entry Forms are in the Golf Shop.

Men's Club Championship – Friday, **August 19th** through Sunday, **August 21st** – **New Rule this year** - Dependents are no longer eligible to compete in this event. This is strictly for the dues paying male member or the husband of a female listed member. If you have a 7.3 Handicap Index then you will play in the Championship Flight Friday-Sunday, all others only play Saturday & Sunday.

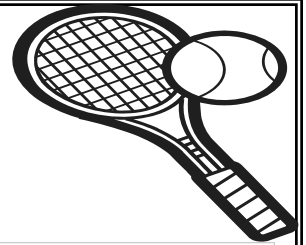

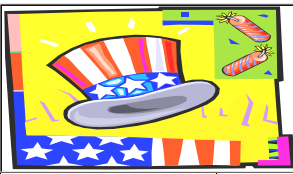

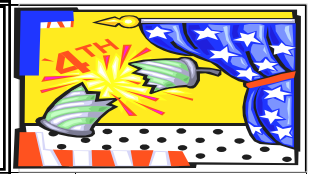
