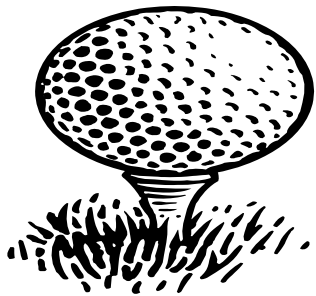

# Fore Your Information

**FROM THE PRO:** The month of March is when we kick off our golf season and there is a lot on the agenda for this month. If you haven't received any emails from me then please send one to [pgajeffcopeland@gmail.com](mailto:pgajeffcopeland@gmail.com) and I'll add you to the weekly update list.

## UPCOMING EVENTS:

**Senior Monthly** – Wednesday, March 9th – 9 a.m. shotgun start. Course is open for regular play.

**Men's Monthly** – Saturday, March 26th – 9 a.m. shotgun start – **This is a week later than usual due to spring break.** Format is individual play with full handicap. We'll flight it and you get to throw out your highest score on a hole on each side. Total score will be based on 16 holes instead of 18.

**Note: The April 16th Men's Monthly will be "The You & Bubba" Scramble, I know this is a member favorite so put it on your calendar.**

**Men's Match Play – Begins Sunday, March 27th and runs through May 30th – Sign-up deadline is March 25th** – You'll have two weeks to complete your scheduled match. Usually two flights based on full handicap. The handicaps will change with each update. You'll play the tees that your handicap is established from. The entry fee is \$30.

**Thursday Scrambles Begin Thursday, March 17th** - Call by 4:45 of each Thursday to sign-up and we'll shotgun start by 5:15 to get done before dark. This is not a straight scramble on every hole, some are modified with getting to choose the best drive and then playing your ball from there. The cost is \$20 and guests are welcome for an additional \$10, includes a golf cart. Open to both men and women!

## JUNIOR CLINICS:

The "*Junior Swing Instruction Clinics*" continue on Saturdays at 2 p.m. for ages 8 & up the first two Saturdays only. This is a 1-hour clinic and there will also be one offered for ages 5 to 7 at 3:10 p.m. for 30-minutes.

On the week of March 13th, this moves to Tuesdays (ages 8 & up at 4 p.m.) and (ages 5-7 at 4:10 p.m.).

*The cost of each "Swing Clinic": Ages 8 & up - \$10, ages 5 to 7 - \$5. If guests, 8 & up - \$15, 5 to 7 - \$10*

Starting on Saturday, March 19th, I will start offering an "*On Course Instruction Clinic*" where I show juniors 8 & up how to play on the golf course including; navigating the course, etiquette and pace of play. This will start at 2:30 p.m. sharp, and last for an hour and a half. For any junior that has never played golf I am encouraging them to attend at least one *Swing Instruction Clinic* prior to coming to the *On-Course Clinic*.

Following this clinic I will have another "On Course Clinic" at 4:15 p.m. for ages 5 to 7. This will last only 45 minutes. *The cost of each "On-Course Clinic": Ages 8 & up - \$15, ages 5 to 7 - \$8. If guests, 8 & up - \$20, 5 to 7 - \$12.* Parents may attend the "On-Course Clinics" and will be provided a golf cart if available.

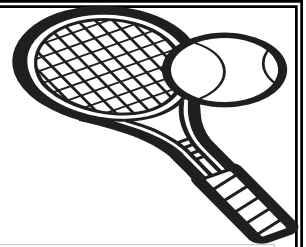
