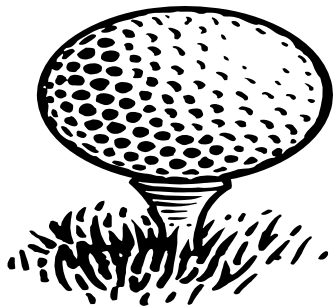

FROM THE PRO:

The Club and Golf Course will be OPEN Memorial Day, Monday the 31st

GOLF CLINICS:

Juniors:

The clinics are every Tuesday after school from 4 to 5 p.m. for 8 year-olds and up and continue every Tuesday until further notice. The cost is \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. The 5 to 7 year old clinic will follow at 5:10 to 5:40 and the cost is \$7 for members and \$10 for guests. Fundamentals and golf etiquette will be the main focus with occasional playing time on the course. Proper attire is required (no gym shorts or tee shirts)

Ladies:

There is a ladies golf clinic each Sunday from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. I hope to offer this every Sunday at the time depending on participation. The cost is \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. A different area of the game will be covered each week with some occasional on course instruction. Call the golf shop to sign up.

GOLF EVENTS:

Special Friday Night Scramble in the Dark – Friday May 7th – I originally had this scheduled for Thursday the 6th but member feedback has prompted me to move this to Friday. This is a 4-Person Team nine hole scramble that will start at dark (around 8 p.m.). The entry fee is \$30 per person and includes all night golf supplies and your cart.

“The Players Championship” Member/Pro Pairing – Saturday the 8th – Tee off anytime - \$20 to draw a pro from The Players field and you combine your net score with your pro’s score from his Saturday round at the Players Championship. This event is optional to play in and does not close the course to other play.

Senior Monthly – Wednesday the 12th – 8:30 a.m. shotgun start

Every Thursday Afternoon Modified Scramble - Call by 5:00 of each Thursday to sign up and we’ll shotgun start by 5:30 to try to get done before dark.

Two-Person Best Ball Invitational – Sat. 22nd & 23rd – Open to anyone (male or female 18 years and up). No handicap required, flighted after 1st round score. **Tee times begin at 7:30 a.m. each day** –

The Course and Range will be closed until the last tee time in the tournament goes off (which depends on the number of players). Entry forms in The Golf Shop. Deadline to enter is May 16th.

Also, during the 1st round of the **Invitational** we will have an optional event in which to participate. The ESPN Two-Person Best Ball Gross and Net Event with full handicap applied (**Must have a valid GHIN Handicap to play in the ESPN Qualifier, if not you can still compete in the gross division**). You can team with either your partner in the Invitational or another player in the field. There is also a senior division (both players must be 55 & up). You can also wheel three other players to team with you. One gross and at least one net winner or maybe two will advance from this qualifier to the Regionals, which will be at Riverchase C.C. in August. **Go to espn.com/golf for more information.**

June 2nd – Wednesday – BGA Junior Boys Event – Course will be closed in the a.m. for this. We should be able to open around noon.

The Lady golfers from Altadena are ranked #3 out of 9 in the Ladies Birmingham Golf Association Team Play. We are proud of our ladies. Keep up the good work.

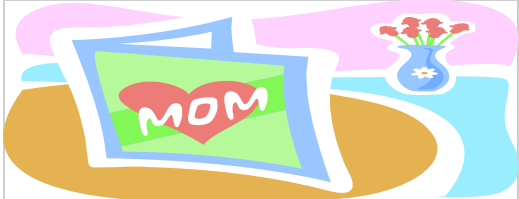

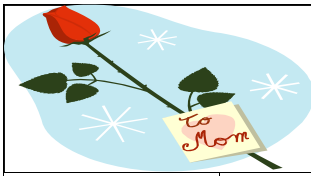

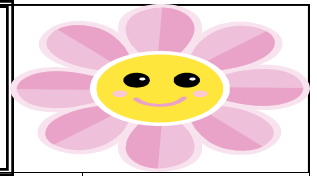
