UPCOMING EVENTS:

Senior Monthly – Wed. 18th – 8 a.m. shotgun start. Course is open for regular play.

Annual Alabama vs. Auburn Dogfight – Saturday November 14th – This is a one side versus the other event, where two players from each side pair up against each other for a 6-hole scramble, 6-hole alternate shot and 6-hole best ball. You win points for your side if you win any of the 6-hole formats. This is open to fans of any teams but you'll play for either Alabama or Auburn. The entry fee is \$35 and guests are welcome to play for an additional \$25. The carts are included and the winning side will also receive \$40 in golf shop credit. You can request pairings and opponents. This is a handicapped event.
