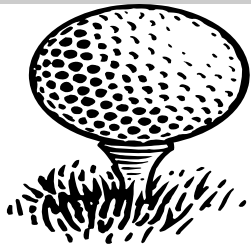

FROM THE PRO:

We now have a Men's Golf Association (MGA). The annual dues are \$25 and this money, along with the proceeds from other MGA sponsored events here at the club, will help fund a selected project approved by the Board to benefit AVCC. If you need more information on this or wish to join, please call the golf shop at 205-967-5324.

GOLF CLINICS:

Juniors:

The clinics are every Tuesday after school from 4 to 5 p.m. for 8 year olds and up and continue every Tuesday until further notice. The cost is \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. The 5 to 7 year old clinic will follow at 5:10 to 5:40 and the cost is \$7 for members and \$10 for guests. Fundamentals and golf etiquette will be the main focus with occasional playing time on the course. Proper attire is required (no gym shorts or tee shirts).

Ladies:

There is a ladies golf clinic each Sunday from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. I hope to offer this every Sunday at this time depending on participation. The cost is \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. A different area of the game will be covered each week with some occasional on course instruction. Call the golf shop to sign-up.

GOLF EVENTS:

“The Masters” Member/Pro Pairing – Saturday the 10th – Tee off anytime - \$20 to draw a pro from The Masters field and you combine your net score with your pro's score from his Saturday round at the Masters. This event is optional to play in and does not close the course to other play.

Senior Monthly – Wednesday the 14th – 8:30 a.m. shotgun start.

Men's Monthly – Saturday the 17th – 8:30 a.m. shotgun start – Individual stroke play with full handicap applied to the holes and flighted – You get to throw out 3 scores; one each on the par 3s, par 4s, and par 5s.

Every Thursday Afternoon Modified Scramble - Call by 4:45 of each Thursday to sign-up and we'll shotgun start by 5:15 to try to get done before dark. The way this works is; we'll alternate which nine holes are played each week with the other nine still open for regular play. We make the teams unless you have requests. Most of the holes will be played by choosing the best drive and then everyone playing their own ball in from there using their handicaps and counting the two low net scores, the other holes are played as a true scramble. The cost is \$20 for members of the MGA and ladies, \$22 if not and guests pay \$32 total. Open to anyone 16 years old and up. Come join in on this great weekly social event.

Third Annual Charity Golf Classic for Down Syndrome – Monday April 26th - 8 a.m. shotgun start – This is a fundraiser with the proceeds going to the Adult Down Syndrome Clinic at UAB. Get your four-person team and help support this worthy cause. The entry fee is \$125 per person and \$500 per team and it is tax deductible (donations are also accepted).
