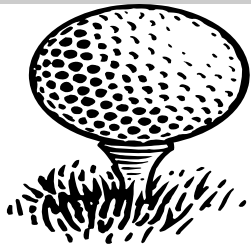

## FROM THE PRO:

### GOLF SHOP:

There are lots of new items in; I can get most anything related to golf even if I don't carry it in the shop, so please give me an opportunity to service your golf needs. In most cases I can match or beat the golf warehouse store's prices.

### GOLF EVENTS:

**The Players' Championship** – Sat. 9<sup>th</sup> & Sun. 10<sup>th</sup> – Pair up with a player from the PGA Tour's Players' Championship that weekend. This is the same as last month's Masters Event. Winners qualify for the season ending championship at no additional cost. This event does not close the course to other play.

**Senior Monthly** – Wed. 13<sup>th</sup> – 8:00 a.m. shotgun start

**Thursday 9-Hole Modified Scrambles** – Every Thursday – Shotgun start at 5:30 and sign-up the day of by 4:30 p.m. The Golf Shop makes the teams and tells you where to start. The format changes weekly, as well as which 9-hole side you'll play. Entry is \$20 and includes cart with golf shop credit awarded.

**Two-Person Best Ball Invitational** – Sat. 30<sup>th</sup> & Sun. 31<sup>st</sup> – Open to anyone (male or female, 18 years and up). No handicap required, flighted after 1<sup>st</sup> round score. **Tee times begin at 7:30 a.m. each day** –

**The Course and Range will be closed until the last tee time in the tournament goes off (which depends on the number of players).** Entry forms in The Golf Shop. Deadline to enter is May 24<sup>th</sup>.

Also, during the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the **Invitational**, we will have an optional event in which you may participate. The ESPN Two-Person Best Ball Gross and Net Event with full handicap applied (**Must have a valid GHIN Handicap to play in the ESPN Qualifier**). You can team with either your partner in the Invitational or another player in the field. You can also wheel three other players to pair with you. One gross and at least one net winner or maybe two will advance from this qualifier to the Regionals, which will be at Riverchase C.C. on August 10<sup>th</sup>. **Go to [espngolf.com](http://espngolf.com) for more information.**
