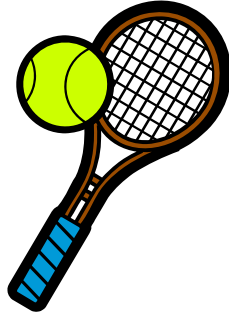
## **UPCOMING MEMBER EVENTS:**
