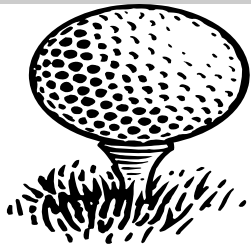

# Fore Your Information

## FROM THE PRO:

You'll see from the schedule of events below, that the month of June is full of Club Events. Please look them over as there are a few days that the course will be partially closed for play.

## GOLF EVENTS:

**Thursday 9-Hole Modified Scrambles** – Every Thursday – Shotgun start at 5:30 and sign-up the day of, by 4:30 p.m. The Golf Shop makes the teams and tells you where to start. The format changes weekly, as well as which 9-hole side you'll play. Entry is \$20 and includes cart with golf shop credit awarded.

**Senior Monthly** – Wed. 10th – 8:00 a.m. shotgun start. Course is open for play.

**Ladies Intercity Event** – Thursday the 18<sup>th</sup> – Course partially closed for this event in the morning only.

**4-Person Scramble To Benefit The Bradley Johnson Memorial Foundation** – Friday June 19<sup>th</sup> - 1:30 shotgun start – Cost is \$85 for members and \$120 for guests – Hole sponsorships available for \$100 – Donations of goods and services also needed for a silent auction. Some money will be set aside to award the winning teams back in Golf Shop Credit. Entry Forms are in the Golf Shop. **The course is open for play in the morning only and all players will have to be off of the course by 1 p.m.**

**The U.S. Open Member/Pro Pairing** – Sat. 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> – Pair up with a player from the U.S. Open Championship that weekend. Winners qualify for the season ending championship at no additional cost. This event is optional to play in and does not close the course to other play.

**Father-Son or Daughter 9-Hole Event** – Sun. 21<sup>st</sup> – All ages welcome. It will be \$10 per 2-person team in a scramble format. There will be tee markers set out for different age groups. Tee off at any time that you wish to play before 4 p.m. Come out and have some fun in this very casual event.

**Junior B.G.A. Boys Event** – Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup> - The Golf Course will be closed until 12 p.m.

**Special Event (ONE DAY EVENT) – McGladrey 3-Person Teams Qualifying Event** – Sat. 27<sup>th</sup> – You make your own team – Format is play your own ball using 50% of your handicap index converted to our course handicap. One low net will count per hole for the team score. Each player must use their score for the team a minimum of three holes. – 8:30 a.m. shotgun start – Teams compete for a chance to play in Montgomery at Willow Point in September and one team from there will qualify to play at Pinehurst in North Carolina in October. **Depending on the number of teams signed up to play, the Course could be closed until completion of this event.**

**Junior Club Championship** – Monday June 29<sup>th</sup> – Tee times start at noon. The age divisions are 5 to 6 (play 4 holes), 7 to 8 (play 6 holes), 9 to 10 (9 holes), 11 to 12 (9 holes), 13 to 14 (18 holes), and 15 to 17 (18 holes).

**Member-Guest Tournament** – July 17<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> – Limited to the first 60 Teams. The cost will be \$400 per team with full details of this fun event in The Golf Shop.

**The Junior Clinics continue on Wednesdays, 8 years and up from 9:30 to 10:30 p.m. and 5 to 7 years old from 10:40 to 11:10 p.m.** They will be conducted every Wednesday at this time until school starts back. Call The Golf Shop for pricing and details (967-5324).

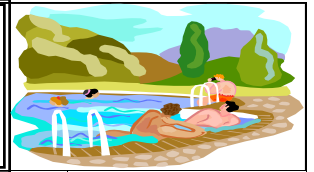
