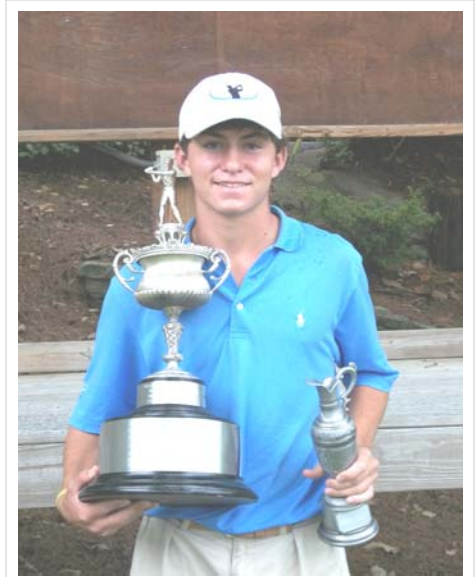




Fore Your Information

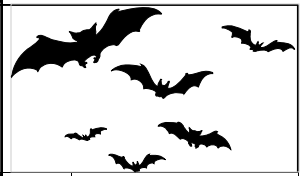


